## COVID-19 Highlighted Problems

- ACTS Roadmap WG refocused 'pilot proposal development' on collaboratively addressing the pandemic
- AHRQ funded the ACTS COVID Collaborative

Integrate ACTS-related efforts and drive progress toward the following goals:

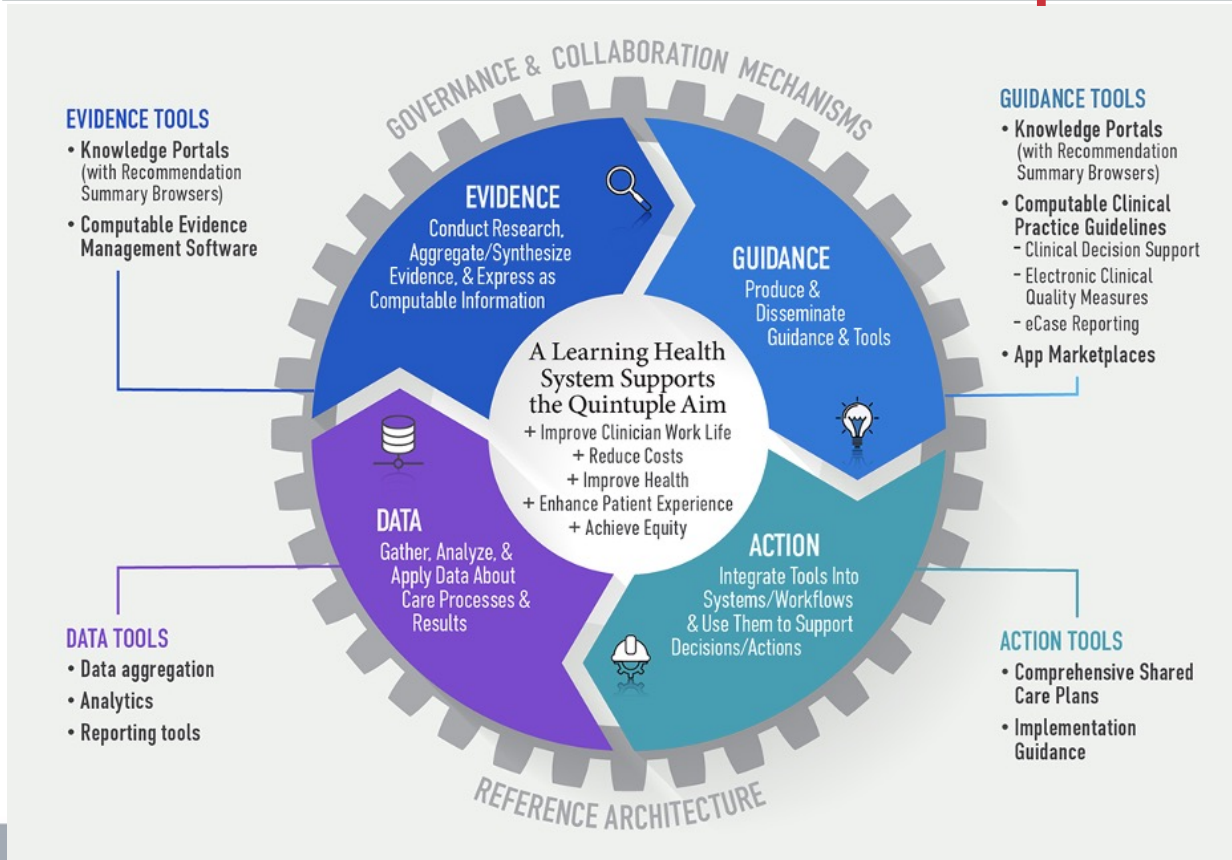
## Near-Term Pandemic Response:

- **Cross-fertilize/accelerate efforts** to develop and deliver (e.g., via CDS) the latest COVID-19 evidence-based guidance to care teams
- **Improve care/outcomes** for COVID-19 for *limited* settings / targets using tools and approaches that can be *broadly scaled*

## Longer-term:

- **Advance tools, standards, and collaborations** that *seed knowledge ecosystem*, reference architecture, and partnerships called for in the ACTS Draft Roadmap

# Future Vision: Digital Knowledge Ecosystem to Foster LHSs and Realize Quintuple Aim

# ACTS Concept Demonstration Goals



## Show care delivery future vision

supported by an effective learning health system (LHS) cycle that realizes the [quintuple aim](#) and addresses urgent healthcare needs



## Highlight elements of future vision

**already in place** (e.g., tools, standards, collaborations, etc.), where the gaps are, and recommended next steps



## Encourage stakeholders to leverage concept demonstration materials

(e.g., patient journey and service blueprint templates) to advance their care transformation and LHS efforts



**Expand Collaboration** on high priority improvement imperatives (related to specific acute and chronic diseases and prevention targets) to focus near-term ecosystem development



**Foster commitments from key public and private organizations** to continue funding and coordination to drive these next steps



**Increase stakeholder engagement** to accelerate progress toward achieving the future vision ([41 ACTS support letters](#) already received)

# LHS Phase 1 Plan

- 3-year **Stakeholder-driven action plan** for *building on Concept Demo* to drive progress toward shared LHS future vision for *several high priority clinical targets*
  - “Phase 1” of 10-year ACTS Roadmap
- Demonstrate digital knowledge ecosystem where **information flows seamlessly around LHS cycle** to *improve care processes / outcomes* for selected targets

## Initial Targets Being Explored for Cross-fertilization:

- Long COVID, COVID Anticoagulation
- Preventive Care (lung cancer screening)
- Pain Management / Opioid Use
- Blood Pressure Control
- Sepsis
- others
